Italy participated with its own expert on the final review of VGSSM hosted in FAO from 12 to 15 April 2016.

The organization of a workshop aiming to disseminate the guidelines for the Sustainable Land Management to stakeholders, is in progress (it may be in September 2017). We keep you informed about the workshop that will be organized by ISP in collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Forestry, the Italian Representation at the UN, and the National Network for Rural Development. Additionally, in view of its future activities, is in program the translation of Guidelines to facilitate the transfer and dissemination among farmers.

Pillar 4 and 5

The ISP is working to collecting and standardizing data for soil organic carbon paper processing at the national level. Additionally, the NFP in view of its mandate, appointed itself to inform the national authorities about the necessity of a call for an official expression of interest in sharing the objective of creating a global soil information system by sharing national soil data collected in a national database. Regardless, the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry has appointed the CREA (Council for Research in Agriculture and Economic Analysis) to represent the point of convergence to promote this sharing.
